



As a Group we have agreed a Code of Conduct that is applicable to all Sections.

This Code is an aid to promote the Principles of Scouting and to assist all our leaders (who are volunteers giving generously of their own time) in planning and running safe, friendly, and exciting activities.

Where it is felt that a Beaver/Cub/Scout has not followed the Code, then the following actions may happen:

- They may be given a warning during the evening and if unacceptable behaviour continues, they may be asked to miss one section meeting. If this happens, a leader will try to ensure that a parent/guardian is informed.
- If the behaviour continues over a period of time, then more Section meetings may be missed (and events outside of weekly meetings). Once again, a leader would ensure that the reasons for this are fully explained to the Beaver/Cub/Scout and the parent/guardian. A plan of action may also be put together to help the individual follow the Code.

We want everyone in our Group to enjoy their Scouting and to participate as fully as they can in the activities and events that we offer.

LISTEN
